  - (a) describing your qualifications for a fellowship;
  - (b) detailing briefly the research project you propose to undertake;
  - (c) relating your anticipated experiences as a fellow to your goals; and
  - (d) indicating clearly why NASA is the appropriate place to conduct the proposed research.

*\* (Send no more than a total of 10 pages of any additional writings. Material cannot be returned.)*

- 4) **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** list below the names and addresses of those whom you have asked to write recommendations on your behalf (at least two and not more than four; use additional sheets if necessary). Letters should address the historical competence of the applicant, his/her ability to apply historical concepts and methods to aerospace science, technology, management or policy, and his/her ability to communicate both orally and in writing. Letters should be sent in sealed envelopes to the Selection Committee at the address below.
